
Chronic Kidney Disease: Identifying Your Stage

There are five stages of chronic kidney disease (CKD). Each stage is associated with a number (GFR) that indicates how your kidneys are functioning. Has your doctor mentioned your CKD stage, GFR, or described your CKD as mild, moderate or severe? See the chart below to determine your stage:
